A DISTINCTLY MAINE STILL WHITE WINE

bright, luscious, analog

Early Light is a unique wine from hybrid grape varieties well-suited to Maine's challenging climate. It's refreshing but in an intricate, savory way: almond and amber notes, and a round, tantalizing softness play well with the bright acidity and cool-climate zip. We farmed the vines on land planted and worked by our friends at Oyster River Winegrowers in Warren, Maine. This is a dry, characterful wine whose complexity will develop with long aging.



DETAILS

- La Crescent and L'Acadie Blanc grapes, hand-harvested September 2024 in Warren, Maine
- gentle pressing by foot, fermentation in used oak barrels
- maturation one year, used oak barrels and glass demijohns
- bottled October 2025 with minimal sulfites

- alcohol 12% by volume
- production: 8 cases (12 bottles/case)
- glass 750mL bottle with Diam cork
